A well-designed building only performs as well as the occupants behave in it and the operators operate it. For the past seven years, the Human Building Interaction Lab, comprising of a dozen graduate students, has been focused on researching how humans interact with buildings, occupant comfort, and building usability. The research includes monitoring, modelling, and simulating occupants; developing self-learning controls and fault detection and diagnostic software; and visualizing data to enhance operator decisions. This talk will provide a series of memorable anecdotes, key research findings, and lessons learned. It is aimed at facilities managers and building owners, building designers, other building professionals.
